
OUR AREAS OF IMPACT

OUR KEY TARGETS

Reduce **energy** consumption by 10% annually

Reduce water use per visitor by 10% between 2021/22 and 2022/23

Maintain our zero **waste**-to-landfill record while working to reduce overall waste tonnage

Promote 'greener' travel options for staff and audiences

Create a detailed catalogue of **materials** to be shared with incoming productions to encourage greater reuse
